I am anxious you will scarcely remember me. It was in 1945 when I worked as P.O.W. at your farm. As I hope you will always have been satisfied with me and because I am now in a terrible want. I ask, whether you can help me a little.

The position in Germany you will certainly know. There is really great need. Above all I have got much sorrow for my two little children. They are in the very age growing up, and therefore their health is in great danger. On the second hand my wife is ill with heart and cannot get any refreshment.

So I beg you to be so kind as to send me a small parcel with some fat or butter, cocoa, and a bit of coffee for my wife.

I hope you will understand my request and I should be glad if you should fulfill my wishes.
