FOREWORD

The Committee on International Exchange of Persons is pleased to make available this list of visiting scholars who are in the United States during the 1964-65 academic year as recipients of awards for lecturing or advanced research under the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act (the Fulbright-Hays Act).

The list is arranged by academic fields and indicates the institutional affiliation of each scholar during his stay in the United States. The majority of scholars arrive in the United States in September and remain for one year, although many extend their stay for a second or, in exceptional circumstances, for a third year. A number of scholars, however, have come to the United States for only brief visits of three to six months. Where the scholar is expected to remain at the same institution for the full academic or calendar year, no period has been specified. For convenience in identifying scholars from various geographic areas, a listing according to the home countries of the scholars has also been included.

It is hoped that this list will be of interest and use to the visiting scholars themselves, as well as to American scholars, educational institutions, and professional organizations. Most of the visiting scholars have educational interests extending beyond their own specialized fields and many would welcome the opportunity to visit other institutions in order to become better acquainted with the philosophies and practices of American higher education.

Communications may be addressed to the scholar in care of the dean of the graduate or professional school of the university with which he is affiliated, or in care of the Conference Board Committee.

A selective list of the visiting scholars who have indicated their interest in giving occasional lectures is also available from the Conference Board Committee upon request.
