PREFACE

A Directory of visiting scholars, who have been awarded grants under the provisions of the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act (the Fulbright-Hays Act) for lecturing and advanced research in the United States, is prepared annually for the use of the scholars themselves, as well as for interested American scholars, educational institutions, and professional organizations.

The exchange program authorized by the above Act is supervised by the Board of Foreign Scholarships, which establishes general policies and selects all participating individuals and institutions. The Department of State, acting through its Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, administers the program with the assistance of binational Educational Commissions and Foundations and United States Embassies and Consulates abroad, and designated cooperating agencies in the United States. The Committee on International Exchange of Persons is the principal private agency in the United States assisting in the administration of the program for university lecturers and advanced research scholars. The Committee, appointed by the Conference Board of Associated Research Councils, is a unit in the National Research Council (National Academy of Sciences -- National Academy of Engineering).

During the academic year 1969-70, scholars in the above category, representing a wide range of academic disciplines, will be in the United States from more than fifty foreign countries. The 1969-70 Directory includes only those scholars whose applications were received or the extensions of whose stay had been approved prior to October 1, 1969, when the list was prepared for publication. It is arranged by academic fields and indicates the institutional affiliation of each scholar, the duration of his appointment, and the major lecturing or research project on which he will be engaged during his stay, based upon the information in his application. The names of the scholars' home institutions have been translated wherever this seemed appropriate. Most of the scholars arrive in the United States at the beginning of the academic year and remain for one year, although a number receive awards for only brief visits of a few months. Many scholars extend their stay for a second or, in exceptional circumstances, a third year. Following the three major field divisions, there is a listing of scholars who received awards under the program for 1969-70, but who will have returned to their home countries by the end of October 1969. For convenience in identifying scholars from various geographic areas, a listing according to home countries has been included after the field listing.

The awards of a majority of the visiting scholars consist of Fulbright-Hays travel grants which supplement stipends provided by their host institutions in the United States. A number of foreign scholars receive full United States Government awards covering both their international travel and maintenance in this country. In many cases, financial support is also made available by private or public organizations in the United States and abroad.

Most of these exchange visitors have educational interests and experience extending beyond their field of major specialization, and would welcome the opportunity to visit institutions other than those serving as their official hosts, in order to become better acquainted with educational practices in the United States and to meet their American colleagues. Institutions or individuals who would be interested in a visit from any scholar on the list, may extend an invitation to the scholar in care of the indicated department or school at his host institution, or in care of the Committee. A large number of these visitors would be pleased to accept invitations to give occasional lectures, either in their special fields or on general topics relating to the history and culture of their respective home countries, and would be able to arrange their schedules to permit brief absences from their regular teaching or research assignments. It is hoped that any scholar who is invited to serve as a guest speaker will have his travel and incidental expenses provided by the institution extending the invitation, and an honorarium, even though modest, would be appreciated. In all cases, it is important that the Committee be informed of any invitation to a visiting scholar, and a brief report on his visit would also be of great value. If an institution wishes to obtain additional information concerning a particular scholar, the Committee will be glad to reply to specific inquiries.
