FOREWORD

The Committee on International Exchange of Persons is pleased to publish this list of visiting scholars who are recipients of grants under the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act (Fulbright-Hays Act) for lecturing or advanced research in the United States during the 1965-66 academic year. The awards to the majority of visiting scholars consist of travel grants which supplement stipends provided by the host institutions in the United States. However, a few of the scholars receive full Government awards which cover all expenses including international travel.

The list is arranged by academic fields and indicates the institutional affiliation of each scholar, as well as the specific research or lecturing project on which he is engaged during his stay in the United States. Most of the visiting scholars arrive in the United States in July or September and remain for one year, although many extend their stay for a second year or, in exceptional circumstances, for a third year. A number of scholars, however, receive awards for only brief visits of three to six months. If the scholar is expected to remain at the same institution for the full academic or calendar year, no period has been specified. At the end of each section is a list of the scholars who have been in the United States for a brief period during the current year and who have returned to their home countries before the end of November 1965. For convenience in identifying scholars from various geographic areas, a listing according to home countries has been included after the field listings.

The titles and home institutions of most scholars have been translated, although a translation has not seemed appropriate in some cases. The field designation is based on the primary research or lecturing subject as indicated by the scholar in his application. It should be noted, however, that most of the scholars have educational interests extending beyond their own specialized fields of research or lecturing and would welcome the opportunity to visit other institutions.

Communications may be addressed to the scholar in care of the dean of the graduate or professional school of the university with which he is affiliated, or in care of the Committee on International Exchange of Persons.

A selective list of the visiting scholars who have indicated their interest in giving occasional lectures is also available from the Committee upon request.
